ADVANCED BUSINESS INTERNSHIPS

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I. ACADEMIC CREDIT

1. Each internship can earn from one to six credits, depending upon duties, responsibilities, l (b) - 42 Tm /F2.0 1 Tf[(t) -1 (i) - n a total of six (6) credits may be granted for Business Internships during a student's career at St. Bonaventure. Up to three (3) credits may be used as a **major** elective requirement (**except Accounting**) or as an accounting minor if approved by the Department Chair. Of course, the internship may be used to satisfy up to six (6) credits of general business electives. **MARKETING & MANAGEMENT MAJORS ARE REQUIRED TO FULFILL ONE 3 CREDIT INTERNSHIP IN ORDER TO GRADUATE.** Students should officially register for the internship during the semester in which they are **completing** the internship requirements.
2. Interns must work approximately 50 hours for **each** academic credit. Thus, a student must work at least 150 hours for three (3) internship credits and at least 300 hours for six (6) credits. Interns may receive academic credit whether they are compensated for their internship performance or not.
3. Internships may be taken during the academic semesters or during the summer months.
